



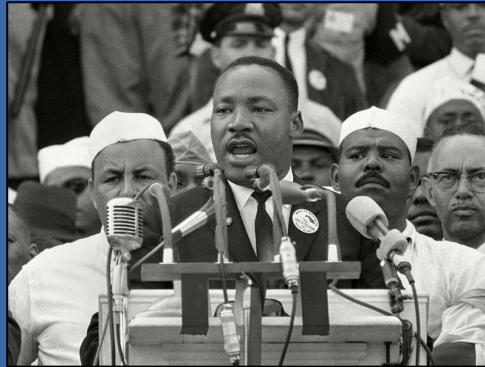
## The “Secret” Vote
