Clandestine Negotiations of Middle East envoys



In December 2017, Palestinian president Mahmoud Abbas cut ties with the Trump administration after United States recognition of Jerusalem as the capital of Israel. The Trump administration further raised Palestinians' ire when it moved the US embassy to Jerusalem in May 2018 and cut hundreds of millions of dollars in annual aid to the Palestinians,^[2] citing the PA's refusal to take part in the administration's peace initiative.^[3]

Early Repercussions



Snap legislative elections were held in Israel on 17 September 2019 to elect the 120 members of the 22nd Knesset. Following the previous elections in April, incumbent Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu failed to form a governing coalition, the first such failure in Israeli history.^[5] On 30 May, the Knesset voted to dissolve itself and trigger new elections, in order to prevent [Blue and White](#) party leader Benny Gantz from being appointed Prime Minister-designate.^[6] This election marked the first time the Knesset voted to dissolve itself before a government had been formed.^[7] ^[8]




Israeli prime minister Benjamin Netanyahu has a lot of problems. He has been accused of corruption, failed to assemble a coalition after winning a recent election and now must campaign in another race in September. To make matters worse, his wife is now officially a convicted criminal.

Sara Netanyahu was accused of aggravated fraud and breach of public trust [last June](#). Netanyahu ordered gourmet takeout to the residence even though her government-funded kitchen had its own chef, flouting state rules and forcing the public to pay for meals.

Prosecutors argued the prime minister and his wife were not entitled to the \$96,000 in take-out ordered between 2010 and 2013, according to the indictment. Ultimately, she pled guilty to lesser charges and today (June 16) was sentenced.

The prime minister's wife faced up to five years in prison on the initial charges against her. In a negotiated settlement, she agreed to plea to "intentionally exploiting the mistake of another" by misleading officials who authorized the expenses, unaware that she already benefited from chefs on the government payroll, [AP reports](#). Her overspending charges were reduced to \$50,000, and she has agreed to pay \$2,800 in fines and return about \$12,500 to the state. ^[9]




The "Russian hoax" of President Donald J. Trump began as an "insurance" policy in the unlikely event he was elected President. With his stunning victory (Politico states it was the largest upset in the history of the United States) the supposed "collusion" between the Trump Campaign and Russia began in earnest with the Federal Bureau of Investigation and Department of Justice. Eventually both the House of Representatives and Senate conducted their own inquiries into the charge of collusion. This attempt by Democrats cannot be attributed to President Trump's peace initiative in the Middle East – thus it cannot be speculated on as a result of the efforts related to TIPP once he took office.



[A formal impeachment inquiry was launched on September 24, 2019](#), as a response to the Trump–Ukraine scandal, in which Trump and his personal attorney Rudy Giuliani pressed the Ukrainian government repeatedly since at least May 2019 to investigate Hunter Biden, the son of 2020 presidential candidate Joe Biden.^{[23][24][25][26][27]} The purpose of the requested investigation was alleged to be to hurt Biden's campaign for President.^{[28][29]} In July Trump issued a hold on military aid scheduled to be sent to Ukraine, releasing it in September after controversy arose. There was widespread speculation that the withholding of the aid was intended to force Ukraine to investigate Biden; both Trump and Giuliani seemed to confirm that there was such a connection.^[30]

In an October 8, 2019 letter to House Democratic leaders, the White House stated it would not cooperate with "[their] partisan and unconstitutional inquiry under these circumstances."^[31] The eight-page letter was widely interpreted by legal analysts as containing political rather than legal arguments.^{[32][33][34][35][36]}

On December 18, 2019, [the House of Representatives impeached Donald Trump](#) almost entirely along party lines.^{[37][38][39][40]}




January 16, 2020 The third Senate impeachment trial of a US president in history convened on Thursday with the reading of the impeachment articles against President Donald Trump and the swearing in of Supreme Court Chief Justice John Roberts and the senators who will decide whether Trump should be removed from office.

The Senate conducted its ceremonial functions of the impeachment trial on Thursday before the actual arguments will get underway next Tuesday. House Intelligence Chairman Adam Schiff, a California Democrat and the lead impeachment manager, read the articles aloud in the chamber while senators looked on from their desks.

Roberts was sworn in shortly several hours later. After Roberts swore in the senators, each present member of the chamber came forward and signed the oath book on the floor of the Senate.

The outcome of the trial is all but determined, as the two-thirds vote required to remove the President would need 20 Republican senators to break ranks. But that doesn't mean the trial itself won't have twists and turns — and potentially some surprises — as Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell navigates the demands of his Senate conference, pressures from Democrats and the whims of Trump and his Twitter account. ^[10]





January 27, 2020 President Donald Trump spoke at a press conference with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on Monday prior to announcing the White House's Mideast peace plan, commenting, "I think in the end [the Palestinians are] going to want it. ... **It's overly good to them.**"

January 27, 2020 *Reuters* reported Monday that a U.S. official said that Trump's message to the two will be: **"You have six weeks to get this [plan] going, if you want it."**

Before getting on their respective flights to Washington, both rivals for the prime minister's seat in the Israeli parliamentary election on March 2 called the plan, which has been dubbed the Deal of the Century, a "historic" plan. They publicly gave it favorable reviews even without knowing all its details, with Netanyahu taking the credit for its supposed pro-Israel angle.

The Israeli leaders will presumably learn many more of its specifics in Monday's meetings, as the president would like to get their public support for it ahead of his news conference with Netanyahu on Tuesday. This is when the plan will reportedly be revealed officially for the first time.

According to Israeli public broadcaster Kan, there is a lot for the right-wing to like in the deal. Reportedly, Israel would be able to annex the entire Jordan Valley and 30 percent of Judea and Samaria, including all the Jewish communities in Area C, which is already under full Israeli control by virtue of accords reached in the 1990s between Israel and the Palestinians. The Jewish State would also keep control of Jerusalem's Holy Basin – the Old City and its environs – including the Temple Mount.



One Day after Accepting TIPP

Netanyahu indicted for corruption in three cases - first for a sitting PM

January 28, 2020: Move comes hours after premier abandons bid for immunity from prosecution; sources close to PM say he is 'the target of obsessive persecution'.

Attorney General Avichai Mandelblit on Tuesday filed the indictment against Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu for charges of bribery, fraud and breach of trust with the Jerusalem District Court.

"The indictment was filed a short time ago... as is required by law," Mandelblit's office said. The move marks the first time in Israel's history that a serving prime minister will face criminal charges, casting a heavy shadow over Netanyahu, Israel's longest-serving prime minister, his legacy and his ongoing attempts to remain in power.

"If anyone still had any doubt that Prime Minister Netanyahu is the target of obsessive persecution, he was now given further clear and sharp proof," the sources were quoted as saying. "The eagerness to file the unfounded indictment against the prime minister is so great that they could not wait even one day until after the historic summit in Washington, one of the most important in the history of the state."^[12]
