"Lady of Death" Another Boil



May 3, 2021: evening private time with the Lord.

A quick glimpse of another boil, separate from the carbuncle, the Lord instructed me to research the "Lady of Death." An aspect of being a prophet that is nauseating but needed as a voice for the Lord in this hour of depravity and lawlessness.

Boils (Carbuncle):

A carbuncle is a red, swollen, and painful cluster of boils that are connected to each other under the skin. A boil (or furuncle) is an infection of a hair follicle that has a small collection of pus (called an abscess) under the skin. Carbuncles can develop in other areas of the body such as the buttocks, thighs, groin, and armpits.

Most carbuncles are caused by *Staphylococcus aureus*bacteria, which inhabit the skin surface, throat, and nasal passages. These bacteria can cause infection by entering the skin through a hair follicle, small scrape, or puncture, although sometimes there is no obvious point of entry. Filled with pus -- a mixture of old and white blood cells, bacteria, and dead skin cells -- carbuncles <u>must drain before</u> they're able to heal. Carbuncles are more likely than boils to leave scars.

An active <u>boil or carbuncle is contagious</u>: the infection can spread to other parts of the person's body or to other people through skin-to-skin contact or the sharing of personal items. Carbuncles require medical treatment to prevent or manage complications, promote healing, and minimize scarring.

Pedophilia:

Medical definition: sexual perversion in which children are the preferred sexual objects specifically. Often described as a psychiatric disorder in which an adult has sexual fantasies about or <u>engages in sexual acts</u> with a prepubescent (ages 9 to 14) child. The International Classification of Diseases defines it as a "sustained, focused, and intense pattern of sexual arousal – as manifested by persistent sexual thoughts, urges or behaviors – involving pre-pubertal children."

Pedophile:

Defined as a person aged 16 years or older who is sexually attracted to or <u>engages in sexual acts</u> with prepubescent children.

The vast majority of pedophiles are male, but the amount of female pedophiles is still much harder to evaluate given that their deviancy can find outlets that are far more discrete. Pedophiles can be found in all social classes and economic strata.

Some are only attracted to boys (boy-lovers), others only to girls, others to both with or without some degree of preference for one. Some pedophiles have specific preferences for children of a certain age span, or possessing particular physical traits (hair, face, constitution, voice, etc.), while others are less specific if at all.

There are exclusive pedophiles (only attracted to children), preferential pedophiles (who prefer children but are also attracted to adults or teenagers) and non preferential pedophiles (who prefer adults or teenagers but are also attracted to children). Some pedophiles live in harmony with their deviancy, which is to them an integral part of their personality. To others, it's a disturbing element, a source of anguish, guilt and shame.

Santa Muerte, Mictecacihuatl (Lady of Death):

Nuestra Señora de la Santa Muerte, often shortened to Santa Muerte, is a cult image, female deity, and folk saint in Mexican neo-paganism and folk Catholicism. A personification of death, she is associated with healing, protection, and safe delivery to the afterlife by her devotees. Despite condemnation by leaders of the Catholic Church, and more recently Evangelical movements, her following has become increasingly prominent since the turn of the 21st century. Originally appearing as a male figure, Santa Muerte now generally appears as a skeletal female figure, clad in a long robe and holding one or more objects, usually a scythe and a globe. Her robe can be of any color, as more specific images of the figure vary widely from devotee to devotee and according to the rite being performed or the petition being made. The cult of the Santa Muerte began in Mexico sometime in the mid-20th century and was clandestine until the 1990s.

Major cult center: Earliest temple is the Shrine of Most Holy Death founded by Enriqueta Romero in Mexico City. Weapon: Scythe. Artifacts: Globe, scale of justice, hourglass, oil lamp. Animals: Owl (Bohemian Grove). Symbol: Human female skeleton clad in a robe. Region: Mexico, Central America, and the (primarily Southwestern) United States Festivals: August 15, A Day of Death.
